

## RESOLUTION

October 10, 2011

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of Miller County, Georgia, and the Mayor and Council of the City of Colquitt, Georgia, in meeting lawfully assembled as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the City and the County did jointly create a recreation system for Miller County, Georgia and the City of Colquitt, Georgia by Resolution dated February 5, 1985; and

**WHEREAS**, a joint Recreation Board was created, composed on nine (9) members: five (5) appointed by the Chairman of the County Commissioners and four (4) appointed by the Mayor of the City of Colquitt; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the change in financing, funding, and practical operation, the City and County are desirous of revising and amending the Parks and Recreation Ordinance as follows:

Sec. 16-5. Same; how funded. shall be amended in its entirety and shall hereafter provide as follows:

**"Sec. 16-5. Same; how funded.**

All funding for the Recreation Board shall be paid for by the Miller County Commission, through tax levy, except grant and/or park revenue. In this respect, the County shall have the sole authority to collect all monies for concession and general admission to any City or County park. Additionally, the County shall be responsible for receiving all donations and the County shall establish a separate bank account for the Colquitt -


Miller County Parks and Recreation. All monies collected by employees of the Parks and Recreation Department shall be collected, accounted for, and turned over to the County on the same day of collection or placed in the deposit box at bank for credit to the County's account. County shall also pay all expenses, salaries, and costs of the Park Recreation Department.


**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of these things, the Board of Commissioners of Miller County, Georgia and the Mayor and City Council of the City of Colquitt, Georgia, do hereby approve and adopt this Resolution amending the Parks and Recreation Ordinance adopted on February 5, 1985 and particularly Section 16-5, and bind themselves to sign and execute this Resolution and place the same upon the official minutes of the City and County the day and year approved, all other terms and conditions of the City-County Park Recreation Ordinance shall remain the same.





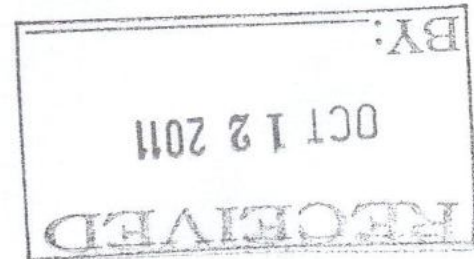
