Dear Vehicle Owner,

Your motor vehicle was purchased in the state of Georgia on or after January 1st, 2012 and prior to March 1st, 2013. As you may know, the state recently passed legislation that gives you the opportunity to opt in to the new Title Ad Valorem Tax from March 1st, 2013 through December 31st, 2013.

What does this mean for you?

The opt in period provides an opportunity to do a comparison between the current annual ad valorem tax, normally paid on your birthday, and the new one-time tax. You may be eligible to opt in to the new tax and get credit for sales tax and annual ad valorem taxes you have already paid.

How do you do a comparison?

The Title Ad Valorem Tax Calculator is now available on our website at <http://onlinemvd.dor.ga.gov/Tag/welcome.aspx>.

Step 1. Enter your VIN information.

Step 2. Verify the information such as purchase date then enter your county information and your vehicle type. Please enter information such as any sales tax paid (if applicable) then click "calculate."

Step 3. Review the estimates to decide whether to opt in to the new Title Ad Valorem Tax OR remain in the current annual ad valorem system based upon the number of years you believe you will own the vehicle.

How do you opt in?

Visit your local county tag office after March 1, 2013 (information is listed above and also available on our website at motor.etax.dor.ga.gov) so that a county tag agent can assist you. Please ensure that you bring all pertinent documentation with you to the tag office (e.g. a bill of sale).
