

RESOLUTION
ADOPTING MILLER COUNTY PRE-DISASTER MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS; to be eligible for federal disaster assistance in the event of a presidential disaster declaration made after November 1, 2003, local governments must have adopted a pre-disaster mitigation plan prepared in accordance with federal regulations promulgated pursuant to the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, and


WHEREAS; in 2010 the Board of Commissioners requested, and subsequently received from the Georgia Emergency Management Agency, a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Planning Grant award to fund preparation of a pre-disaster mitigation plan in accordance with federal regulations promulgated pursuant to the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, and


WHEREAS; the Colquitt/Miller County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan has been prepared as a multi-jurisdictional document to satisfy pre-disaster mitigation planning requirements for the Miller County Board of Commissioners and the City of Colquitt, and

WHEREAS; the Georgia Emergency Management Agency has officially notified the Miller County Board of Commissioners and the City of Colquitt that the Colquitt/Miller County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan satisfies applicable federal pre-disaster mitigation planning requirements.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Miller County Board of Commissioners, Mayor and City Council of the City of Colquitt, each meeting in regular session, will participate in the Colquitt/Miller County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan 2011 and will adopt the plan upon approval by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
